A Safety Manager ensures that the company complies with health and safety regulations.

Safety Managers establish and implement policies that will create and maintain a safe workplace. They evaluate practices, procedures and facilities to assess risk and adherence to the law, monitor compliance by inspecting employees and operations, equipment and machinery to observe possible unsafe conditions. Other activities include investigating accidents or incidents to discover causes and handle worker's compensation claims, recommending solutions to issues, improvement opportunities or new prevention measures, reporting on health and safety awareness, issues and statistics. They may also conduct and evaluate safety levels for products.
